Consequently, if a customer requires an after sales service from which he/she has purchased the system may be refused by the company as it no longer have any distributorship contract with the manufacturer of the product.

As ACER appoints only one distributor in a country, buyers of ACER products will have to call the

people for all kinds of aftersales service. This ensures reliability and confidence of the ACER users on the ACER as a

Raymond further informed that ACER has assembling plants in different key locations around the world. The main parts of their computer products are shipped to these centers where they are assembled according to the local requirements. This enables the ACER users to enjoy all the facility of a global brand with the warmth of local touch

When asked by Computer Jagat to give some details about the most important event for ACER in '96. Raymond informed that a memorable 20 year celebration of ACER took place in its Talwan headquarter from June 25 to 27 which was attended by 2.000 distributors and business partners from

90 countries of the world.
